I thankfully acknowledge and appreciate the esteemed members of the Board of Management for their continuous support, guidance and encouragement in all our endeavours.





ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022

It is indeed a great delight to present the annual report for the year 2021-2022.

The year 2021 -2022 was exciting, challenging and invigorating. We have always worked with the mission and the vision of the college in mind. We set our own standards, strived to reach them and elevated ourselves to higher planes. The learning, the evolving and the efforts will never cease .The academic year has been a stupendous success with both curricular and co-curricular activities. Some of the highlights of the year are briefed below.

Installation of the Principal

The academic year began with the installation of our new Principal Dr. Sujatha Christopher by our respected Bishop Rt. Rev. Dr. P. K. Samuel, in the presence of the members of the Board of Management, Dignitaries, Staff, Students and well wishers on Oct 12th 2021.

Staff Orientation & NEP Workshop

We commenced the academic session in October 2021. It began with an orientation programme with the sole purpose of bringing the various faculty members together to reflect and prepare for the year ahead. Rev. Jayanesan Presbyter In –Charge, Memorial Church led us in prayer. The orientation was followed by a workshop on the National Policy of Education. The Resource person was Dr. S. Muralidhar, Professor and Head Department of Commerce & Management, Govt. First Grade College, Kolar. He is also a member of the Sub Committee – Governance & Regulation Task Force for implementation of NEP in Karnataka .He elaborated on the salient features of the National Policy of Education and made the staff aware of various aspects regarding subject specific disciplines , open electives, internal assessment etc.

Student Orientation

The academic year for the first year students began with an orientation programme organized on 29th Oct 2021, for the benefit of the students who are about to experience a new phase in life.

The Fresher's were acquainted by the Principal about the Vision, Mission and Motto of the institution, the rules and regulations to be followed, semester scheme, Internal Assessment .They were also made aware of the New Education Policy and its aims and objectives.

Results

As always ,our students performed very well academically. Few students scored 100 out of 100 in some subjects . Many students also secured distinctions in the examinations conducted by Bangalore North University. The results in each department had a radical increase of above 90%.

Staff Development and Achievement

We are pleased to inform that two of our staff members have obtained their Doctorate Degree .A few staff are also pursuing their doctorate degree. As the National Education Policy was introduced this year, members of the teaching staff actively participated in seminars and workshops organized by Bangalore North University and its affiliated colleges to be abreast of the aims and objectives, new syllabus, internal assessment etc. Few staff presented and published papers in various National and International conferences and journals.

Seminars/ Workshops/Guest Lectures

To keep up with changing times and the latest trends and for quality enhancement, seminars, workshops and guest lectures were organized within the campus. Eminent resource persons were invited.

Industrial Visits

To give the students a hands on experience and a first hand knowledge on the working of an industry the B.B.A ,Commerce ,Science and Psychology department organized industrial visits.

The department of Botany organized an industrial visit to Azyme Bioscience.

The students of Psychology visited-Aparna Children's Home.

The Commerce department took their students to Mysore Silks Ltd. and the Management department took their students to Hanuman weaving factory.

Extra Curricular Activities

The College organized talent's week to bring out hidden talent among the students. Fresher's day was organized to welcome the fresher's to the goodwillian family. Elections were conducted in a democratic manner. Students were given ample time for campaigning. The whole procedure was conducted in a systematic manner under the strict supervision of the lecturers.

The newly elected council members dressed in white formally took their oaths of office at the Investiture ceremony. Rev .Mary Shalini, Presbyter, Divya Shanthi Church was the Chief Guest.

Republic Day and Independence day

Students participated in a parade for the Republic day. The 75th anniversary of Indian Independence was celebrated with great solemnity. The program started with a prayer and a reading from the word of God, followed by a cultural program.

Annual Athletic Meet

To encourage the students to take active part in sports and to develop the spirit of sportsmanship the college conducted its Annual Athletic meet. The Chief Guest was Ms. Nisha Mohite Gaikwad, International Asia-Pacific swimmer.

NSS

The NSS wing of our college organized numerous activities. Blood donation camps, awareness programs on health and hygiene, human rights, legal literacy etc., were organized.

Civil Defence

The Civil Defence unit of our college took active part in all the activities organized by the State Civil Defence Wing. The civil defence students were part of the state parade too.

Placement and Career Guidance

In order to help final year students in their decisions regarding their future, the career guidance cell organized career counselling programmes. The final year students were also given opportunities to take up aptitude tests conducted by the companies that visited the campus. Few of our students have been selected by reputed companies.

Student Achievement

Our students participated in Inter-Collegiate sports and cultural fests and have won laurels. Ms. Sanjana Shetty of I B.com participated in the All India National Federation Cup 2021 organised by Youth and Sports Promotion Association of India at Goa from 25th to 27th November 2021 and won 4 Medals.

Our fashion team participated in a Inter-collegiate Fest 'Ecclesia', organised by St. Anne's first Grade Degree College for Women. As It was an open theme, they decided to go with Indo-Western, the fusion of Western and South Asian fashion to bring out the uniqueness of outfits in different ways. They bagged the first place and were awarded with a cash prize. Our students also won 3rd place in Fashion Sequence & Dance at Govt. RC College.

INSTALLATION OF THE PRINCIPAL



“The start of something new brings the hope of something great”

The academic year 2021-2022 started with installation of the new Principal, Dr. Sujatha Christopher. She took the mantle of leadership of Goodwill Christian College on 12th October 2021. The installation service was conducted under the leadership of Bishop Rt. Rev. Dr. P.K. Samuel, in which he addressed the gathering and installed Dr. Sujatha Christopher as the Principal of the college. This was followed by Principal's speech. On behalf of the Goodwill Staff, Mrs. Hazel D' Souza welcomed the new Principal. The staff choir gave a special song 'Footsteps Walking with Me'. The program was witnessed by the members of the Education committee, Heads of Institutions, Staff and Students of GCCW.

ACHIEVEMENTS ON UP GRADATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE

The infrastructure of a college plays a vital role in the development of the college. Education infrastructure - building, classrooms, laboratories, and equipment etc., are essential elements of learning in Institutes of higher learning. There is strong evidence that high-quality infrastructure facilitates better instruction, improves student outcomes, and reduces dropout rates, among other benefits. With a focus on quality as the defining value of education, we aimed at improvising and upgrading our existing infrastructure for the betterment and development of the Institution.

Given below are some of the contributions made towards preserving, maintaining and expansion of the campus.

- **Electric Connections**

The electricity wire for the college was right across the road hanging dangerously in the open. Due to heavy rains, the wire fell on the night of 20th May 2022. With the help of BESCO a new electric pole was installed in the college premises (Rotary Club area).

- **Generator Shed**

Generators are designed to produce powerful voltage and when moisture gets into the outlets or seeps into the engine, it can cause considerable damage. To prevent this, a shed was erected to combine all the protection aspects for generators, including sound attenuation & weather protection. Further, the generator in college had to be manually operated and this was upgraded to be automatic.

- **UPS**

Digital Video Recorder (DVR) meant for the CCTV cameras had to be up and running always and hence, needed UPS connection uninterrupted. However, the UPS was found to be of no use as the existing batteries have been out of charge. Hence, the UPS connections were thoroughly checked and upgraded providing adequate power during short-term interruptions and 'ride-through' time to convert to backup supply.

- **Efficient use of the Borewell**

As the college spends a considerable amount of money every month for its water needs and depends on BWSSB, the existing bore well in the polytechnic block is now utilised by the Institution.

- **Demolition of the old Hostel Building**

The old hostel building was in a dilapidated condition with the fear of its collapse at any given point of time causing further damage to property and posed a threat to life. Based on the decision taken by the Board of Management, the old building was demolished and the work duly completed keeping in mind the safety of the students.

- **Parking Space**

There was a dire need for adequate parking space for vehicles of staff & students. All the while, the vehicles were parked close to the generator which is unsafe and was also a hindrance to the smooth conduct of the college assembly. To solve this problem, the vacant space after the demolition of the hostel building has been converted into a parking lot.

- **Compound wall**

As per the board's decision, it was decided to go ahead with the construction of the compound wall that collapsed due to heavy rains in October 2021. A new compound wall was thus constructed.

- **Food Court**

As the primary function of the canteen is to serve nutritious and hygienic food to the students & staff in a clean environment, a new food court was constructed.

- **Painting**

The security room, kitchen, UPS room and compound wall were painted giving them a brand-new look. In addition, the newly built compound wall was also painted.

- **Banners**
As most of our students are top achievers in the university exams, a banner was put up at the entrance to honour their achievements.
- **Uniform for Sub staff**
The sub staffs were provided with good uniforms to be worn on specific days and occasions.
- **Classrooms**
With the advent of the NEP, all undergraduate courses now span 4 years instead of the existing 3 years leading to shortage of classrooms. To accommodate this change, classrooms were acquired from the erstwhile goodwill polytechnic and have been efficiently used. Students from the BCA & BA departments have their regular classes there.
- **CCTV Cameras**
For the safety and security of our students, in addition to the existing ones ten cameras with night vision were recently installed.
- **Automatic bell**
An automatic bell was installed saving man power and money. Moreover it is also accurate.
- **Plumbing**
Leaking taps were fixed, faucets replaced, and maintenance of the labs were done.
- **Library**
Quite a number of books were added to the library from the erstwhile goodwill polytechnic library.
- **Computer Lab**
As computing resources are of primary importance to any Institution, the computer lab was upgraded based on the need. All the systems were upgraded to the latest Microsoft OS and other necessary software and are in perfect working condition. Also, the lab is fully functional at any given point of time and is not affected by any power surges or loss as it is also connected to the new UPS system.
- **Sports Facility**
The vacant space in the polytechnic block is now being used as for sports activities. Our students regularly play shuttle and few other games.
- **Stage Tent and Backdrop**
Our college hosts a number of curricular and extra- curricular activities at the centre stage in the college quadrangle. For this purpose we hire a stage tent for every occasion which is expensive. To cut costs, we have erected a permanent stage tent thus saving money, manpower and time. In addition to all the above, it is also very crucial for our students to have a pleasant learning environment. To make the campus look eco - friendly the following initiatives were taken up.
- **Maintenance of the Botanical Garden**
Many plants were planted to the botanical garden in addition to the existing plants. Hanging pots were also put up enhancing the beauty of the campus. All the Pots were completely re-potted & uniformly painted. The garden is thus very well maintained.
- **Bird Enclosure**
An enclosure for birds has been put up around the mango tree near the entrance adding beauty to the campus.

Thus, the academic year 2021-2022 witnessed improvisations in physical facilities so to be on par with academic activities. We sincerely thank our Chairman, Bishop Dr. Rt. Rev. P. K. Samuel, Officers of the Diocese, and the members of the Board of Management for their unflinching dedication in improving the quality of education and the infrastructure involved with it.

INAUGURATION OF CANTEEN

Under the able leadership of our respected Principal, Dr. Sujatha Christopher our new food court ' Goodwill Café was initiated to provide wholesome nutritious food. The café was inaugurated on the 19th of September 2022 by our Bishop CSI Karnataka Central Diocese and Chairman ,Board of Management Rt. Rev. Dr. P.K. Samuel, in the presence of the Members of the Board of Management, Principal, Staff & Students.



DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Report on Guest Lecture- Department of English

The department of English organised a Guest Lecture on 8th August 2022 on the topic 'Importance of Effective Communication'. The program started with an opening prayer by Ms. Dorris Nivedha of III BA invoking God's choicest blessings, followed by Mrs. Leena Elizabeth from the Dept. of English formally welcoming the gathering. Our respected Principal Dr. Sujatha Christopher addressed the students by giving them an insight on effective communication and why it is so important in today's world. Dr. Lydia from the Dept. of English introduced the speaker Mr. Terrance Richard, CEO of Richie Films and a motivational speaker. He spoke on the importance of effective communication by offering a few tips in aiding communication such as preparing the mind of the listener, taking time to listen rather than interpret etc. He emphasised that the first

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY - ONE DAY SEMINAR

The Department of Chemistry organised a one day seminar on 28th July 2022 on the topic 'Nanomaterials'. The program started by invoking God's choicest blessings and lighting of the lamp by our Principal Dr. Sujatha Christopher and Heads of the Department and Guests of the day. Our guest speaker was Dr. Mrs Jacqueline Rajamathi, Head of the department of Chemistry, Bishop Cotton Women's Christian College. He presented a beautiful and colourful PPT. The session was so interesting, interactive, and all the students enjoyed looking at the amazing orchids and the humorous and knowledgeable lecture of Dr. A.K. Bopaiah sir.



INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO AZYME BIOSCIENCES BY DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

The Department of Botany has organised a one-day industrial visit to Azyme Biosciences on 2nd August 2022. As a part of the syllabus in Botany paper VIII, VI semester students should visit an industry that deals with alcohol production / enzyme production / visit to any bio labs. During their visit, students learnt various laboratory techniques like HPLC, GC, PCR, Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer, UV spectrophotometer, Visible light spectrophotometer, etc. Students were briefed about the operation of the instruments and their uses by Dr. Purushotham.



The Department of Botany organised a one-day certificate course on "Mushroom Cultivation and Nursery Technics" at Bio centre, Hulimavu, Bengaluru on 20-8-22 for all the B.Sc. students. Dr. Rukhmini, assistant director of Bio centre, trained the students on the above topic.

JOURNALISM DEPARTMENT

Journalism Department celebrated National Journalism Day and world television day on December 10, 2021.

Journalism day is celebrated to honor the Press Council of India (PCI), which was established on the same day 55 years ago. The PCI was constructed as an instrument to not only keep a check on the quality of reportage in the country but also to ensure independent journalism.

To commemorate the same, Journalism department conducted various competitions such as photography and debate competitions. For photography competition the theme was 'our college' and for debate competitions the topics were 'Is it good or bad to post personal content on social media' and 'Does television content affect you positively or negatively'.

To memorialize World television day 'News reading' competition was held, where Journalism students had to take a current affair topic and prepare a news bulletin on the same and make a video of it. Active participation was observed in this competition.

This was a great learning experience as told by the students. Learning outcome of this was confidence, communication skills and much more.



Journalism department organized a guest lecture for students of Bachelor of Arts on the topic 'Different Applications of Computers in Media' on September 7th, 2022.

The speaker Mr. Prashanth Bholu, an entrepreneur in a cyber security firm-Offensive Tech, shared his knowledge on various computer applications such as Adobe audition, Premier Pro, Photoshop, Coreldraw, PageMaker, Indesign and Quarkexpress which are widely used these days by the media in designing newspaper, magazine, videos and for producing audio also.



Overall the guest lecture was a productive one, as all students learnt the importance and usage of computers and their relevance in the industry.



PSYCHOLOGY GUEST LECTURE & INDUSTRIAL VISIT

Psychology department organized a guest lecture for the students on the topic 'Mental Health and Depression' on September 7th 2022.

The speaker Mr. Shah Sharif, founder of Samarthan an NGO, shared his life experiences and the practical knowledge of how to overcome depression and to have a positive mental health. He briefed the students to let go off their negative feelings through demonstrations.

Overall the session was an interactive one where students also shared their views and gained practical knowledge. They understood the importance of maintaining a well-balanced mental health.




EVENT REPORTS

GRADUATION CEREMONY




