Some of the highlights of the year were;

Installation of the Principal:

The academic year began with the installation of our New Principal Dr.Sujatha Christopher by our respected Bishop Rt. Rev. Dr. P.K. Samuel , in the presence of the members of the Board of Management , Dignitaries ,Staff ,Students and Well wishers.

Introduction of New Courses- B.Sc in Home Science was the new course that was introduced this year in addition to the existing BA, B.Com and B.Sc, BBA and BCA courses.

Staff orientation & NEP Workshop :

We commenced the academic session in October. It began with an orientation programme with the sole purpose of bringing the various faculty members together to reflect and prepare for the year ahead. .
